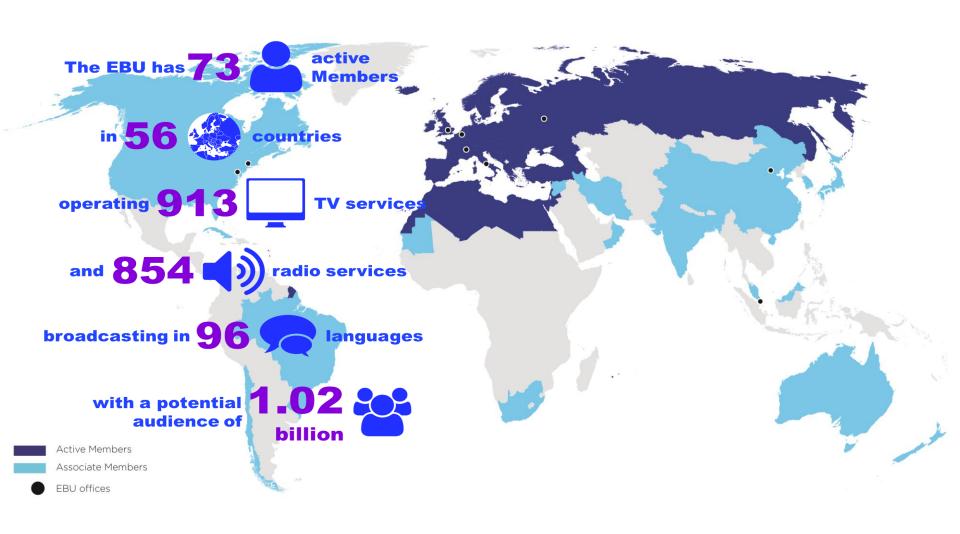

 - UHDTV, spectrum, etc.



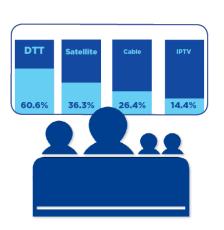
Things you might not know ...

- WiFi is still the "wireless" broadband network of choice for viewers (and thus broadcasters)
 - Broadcasters don't consider MNO-operated wireless broadband as a key access network

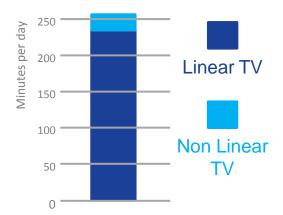


DTT in Europe

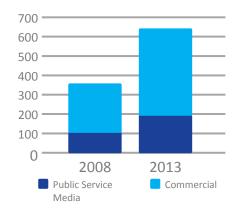
118 million households rely on DTT

How is Analogue Switch Off (ASO) going?

- It depends
 - Market share of DTT rising in Poland, but falling in Switzerland
- Basic rule
 - Make sure the whole industry is part of ASO process
 - Win-win for all!!



Some trends

- Immersion:
 - UHDTV 4xHDTV with better sounds targetting bigger TV's >50".
- Personalisation:
 - Recommendation Systems and OTT on your TV set from a broadcaster, not just Netflix/Apple.
