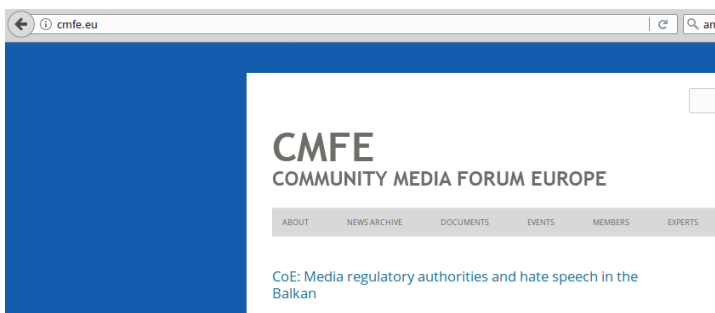

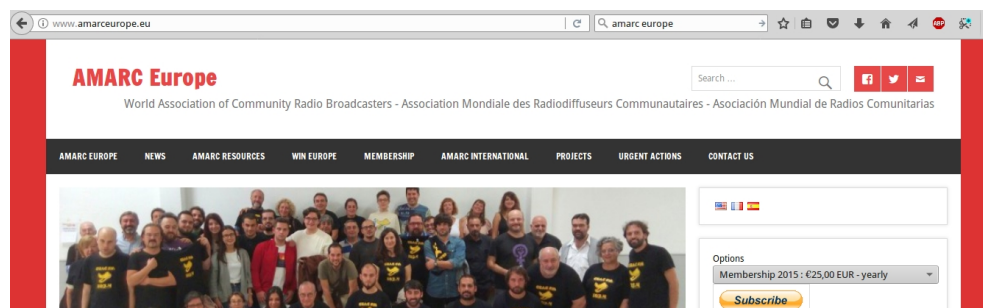

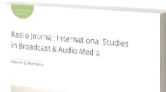

EUROPEAN MEDIA AGAINST HATE SPEECH

WITH SUFFICIENT SAFEGUARDS FOR FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION, WE CONSIDER THAT ENSURING 'HATE SPEECH' PROVISIONS SHOULD BE INCLUSIVE OF THE BROADEST RANGE OF PROTECTED CHARACTERISTICS. 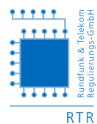

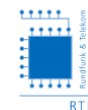
