





Respeaker listens to the program and dictates to the microphone.


Speech recognition software generates text


Strategy: Adopt the Mechanisms of Re-Speaking to Sign Language

- Cooperation Human with Machine
- **Remote**: Interpreter can work from anywhere via Internet
- **Live**: System is optimized to be used in a live workflow
- **Transparent Change** of Interpreter
- Open Distribution to TV, HbbTV, Web , App
- Reusable for VOD
- Collect Data to Improve






First Pilot of Avatar – Based on «Action TV»












HBBTV Broadcast Mix vs. Receiver Side Mix



Phase 1: Original Video plus Signer (Avatar / Human) mixed before playout HbbTV 1.4 +



Phase 2: Original Video plus Signer (Avatar / Human) are delivered as clean Feed HbbTV 2.x +

Partnerships: Content4All

- European funded Horizon 2020 project
- September 2017 and August 2020
- Aim: make more content accessible for the sign language community by implementing a sign-translation workflow with a photorealistic 3D human avatar.


