2021: *Taskforce formalised as EMIL*



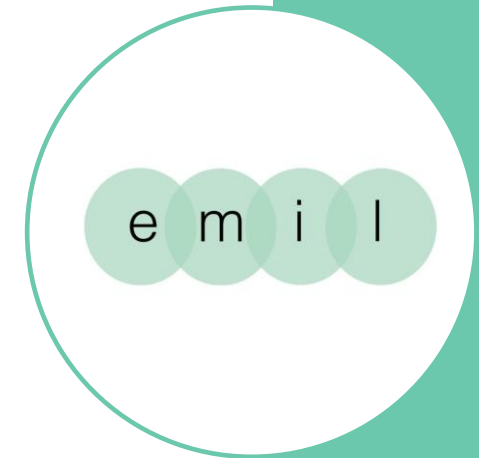

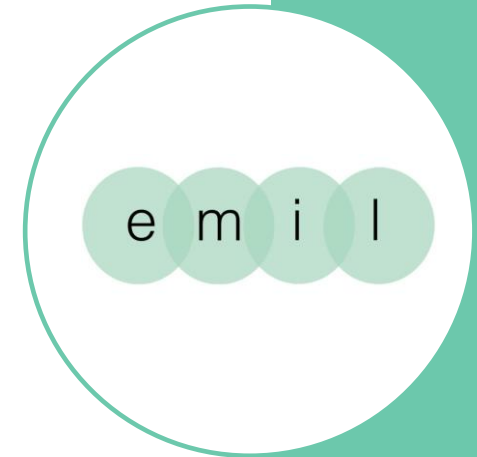

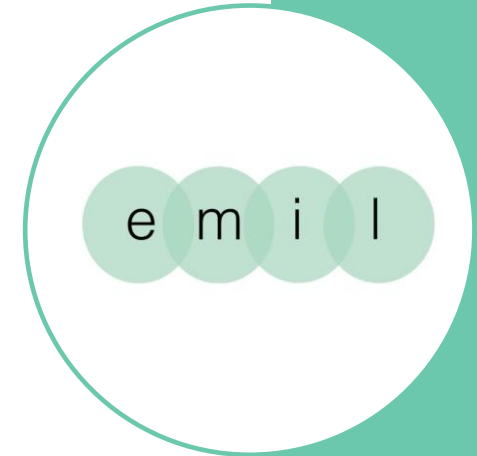
