

#### Relevance


 PSM brings information, culture, education (and entertainment) with public value

 Enables people to form opinions based on different perspectives and views

A safeguard for democratic rule of law





# The PSM system should change

#### **Characteristics Dutch PSM system**

- Emphasis on organizations instead of public content
- A lack of review and settlement of contribution to the public media remit
- Unclear division of tasks and responsibilities between the coordination organization and member broadcasters
- High threshold for makers to contribute
- Conflicting interests in profiling as a PSM as a whole vs. individual member broadcasters



#### Design requirements

#### Requirements following from analysis

- Clear roles and responsibilities
- Guarantee of transparency and clear decision-making
- Mechanisms for review and evaluation of players
- Accessible to diverse content creators


