CDSMI current work

To be adopted/approved at the CDMSI Plenary on 3-5 December 2025:

- ✓ Recommendation on Online Safety and Empowerment of Content Creators and Users
- ✓ Guidance Note on the <u>Implications of Generative Artificial Intelligence</u> for Freedom of Expression
- ✓ Guidelines for National **Media and Information Literacy (MIL) Strategies** Practical Steps and Indicators
- √ 10 Building Blocks to Counter Disinformation and Build Information Integrity
- ✓ Feasibility Study on Immersive Reality Applications and their Implications for Freedom of Expression



CDMSI forthcoming work

Adoption/approval by the CDMSI by the end of 2027 (TBC):

A Recommendation on Media Pluralism in the Online Environment:

-> guidance to member States and digital platforms on how to **protect and promote diverse, pluralist and independent media in the online environment**.

A Guidance Note on Media Regulators in a Platform-Based Environment:

-> to support member States, media regulators, and other relevant actors in ensuring that **media regulators can continue to fulfil their essential functions in the digital age** — with independence both in law and in practice, and with the necessary remit, resources, and powers to operate effectively.



Composition of Expert Committees

- **▶**13 Members -> 7 elected by the CDMSI from candidates proposed by Member States
- > 6 independent experts
- > Work starting from a **background study** we are currently commissioning
- >Two meetings per year for two years (possibly in March and September)
- Final adoption/approval by the CDMSI by the end of 2027
