The Commission is comprised of **11 members**: two members are appointed by the President of the Republic, three members are appointed by the Parliament on the recommendation of the Parliament Committee for Culture (one member out of the three – from the opposition fractions), one member is appointed by the Lithuanian Bishops' Conference, three members are appointed by the Association of Lithuanian Artists, one member is appointed by the Association of Lithuanian Journalists and one member is appointed by the Union of Lithuanian Journalists.

Members of the Commission are appointed for the **4 years period** for no longer than **2 terms in turn**.
